In 1994, Haller left Dow and joined the chemical distribution company, Plüss-Stauffer AG, as Managing Director, a position he held for five years before being appointed Chief Executive Officer of Red Bull Sauber AG and Sauber Petronas Engineering AG. In March 2002, he moved to Allianz Capital Partners GmbH as one of the company's Managing Directors and remained there for four years until he rejoined Dow.

Haller returned to Dow in June 2006 and assumed an executive leadership role in a variety of areas including his current one in Performance Products.

He is a member of the Board of Directors for the Dow Corning Corporation, and the Michigan Molecular Institute. He is a member of the Dow AgroSciences Members Committee.

Haller holds a master's degree in business administration from IMD, Lausanne, Switzerland and earned a certification in the advanced executive program from UCLA, Los Angeles, California.
